The Admin Awards was founded in 2012 by Sunny Nunan, the daughter of a career Executive Secretary who witnessed firsthand the extraordinary impact Administrative Professionals have inside organizations.

Inspired by her mother, Jeannette Castellano, who served in the profession until retiring just shy of her 80th birthday, Sunny created the world's first public recognition program dedicated to celebrating the achievements of Administrative Professionals.

Today, the Admin Awards is widely recognized as the Administrative Profession's highest honor, celebrating the professionals who help leaders, teams, and organizations succeed.

What began as a personal mission has grown into a national platform elevating those whose contributions are often essential yet rarely recognized.



# Continuing the legacy of Colleen Barrett, Southwest Airlines

The Colleen Barrett Award for Administrative Excellence is the Admin Awards' most prestigious honor.

Colleen Barrett was the legendary Executive Assistant at Southwest Airlines who rose to President & COO during her five-decade career at Southwest.

Herb Kelleher, Southwest's visionary CEO leveraged Colleen's extraordinary gifts for strategy, leadership, and interpersonal relationships that enabled her to be the guiding force behind Southwest's renowned "people first" culture.

# How the Admin Awards Works

The Admin Awards begins with a nomination and culminates at the Admin Awards "Good as Gold" Gala, the defining moment of the program where nominees are publicly recognized and Finalists and Winners are revealed live.

## Companies Nominate Their Admins or Administrative Teams

- Organizations submit nominations in the Admin Awards region of their choice in one or more of the Admin Awards categories, recognizing Administrative Professionals whose contributions create meaningful impact.
- All Nominees must be present at the Admin Awards 'Good as Gold' Gala to advance in the competition.

## Independent Judges Review All Nominations

- Every nomination is reviewed by an independent Board of Judges composed of former Admin Awards winners, executives, and the Colleen Barrett Institute.
- There is no public voting.
- Finalists and Winners are selected based on merit and demonstrated impact presented in written nominations.

## The Admin Awards 'Good as Gold' Gala Recognition Experience

- Nominees and their executives and coworkers attend the five-star rated Admin Awards 'Good as Gold' Gala. Friends and family are also welcome and do attend.
- Every Nominee is honored, and the Finalists and Winners are revealed live throughout the evening.
- Every attending Admin enjoys many long-standing traditions of the Admin Awards including a red-carpet experience, high-value commemorative gift and a chance to win extraordinary prizes throughout the evening.

The Admin Awards was intentionally built around a shared recognition experience. Attendance at the Gala is therefore required for nominees who wish to advance in the competition.

# 3 Ways to Nominate

## Nominate an Individual

Submit a nomination in one or more Admin Award categories. This is how the vast majority of companies participate and recognize the outstanding contributions of Administrative Professionals.

## Nominate Yourself

Administrative Professionals may submit a self-nomination to share the achievements and contributions they are most proud of. Self-nominations often spark additional nominations from leaders and colleagues.

## Nominate an Administrative Team

For Administrative teams that work closely together toward a shared goal or objective, the Team Achiever Award recognizes the power of collaboration and the collective impact of the team.



# How Nominations Work

The Admin Awards begins with a nomination and culminates at the Admin Awards Good as Gold Gala, where nominees are publicly honored and Finalists and Winners are revealed live.

## Submit a Nomination

Nominations are submitted online at [adminawards.com](https://adminawards.com). The form takes just a few minutes to complete and there is no login. Nominations may be submitted by executives, colleagues, peers, clients, or vendors. Self-nominations are welcome as well.

## Nominee Notification

Once a nomination is submitted, the nominee is notified and receives a unique supporting nomination ("Fan Club") link that can be shared with colleagues, leaders, and peers who wish to submit additional nominations.

## Supervisor Notification

If the nominator is not the nominee's direct supervisor, the system also notifies the nominee's supervisor that their Administrative Professional has been nominated and encourages them to submit a nomination of their own. A nomination from the leader they support is considered an important part of the nomination process.

## Nominee Acceptance

Nominees are then invited to accept their nomination, verify their information, and submit a short Nominee Statement highlighting their contributions and achievements.

## Nominations Portal

Our Nominations Portal allows nominees and nominators to log in anytime to view nominations, track supporting nominations, and manage submissions in one place.

## Nominee Preparation Call

All nominees are invited to attend a Nominee Preparation Call held via Zoom approximately one month prior to the Gala. During this call, we review the nomination process, judging timeline, and what to expect at the Good as Gold Gala.

The Admin Awards features distinct individual award categories that reflect the diverse talents and contributions of today's multi-faceted community of Administrative Professionals. In addition, we present the Team Achiever Award, recognizing Administrative teams that rally around a common goal and demonstrate the power of collaboration in achieving shared objectives. Submitting a nomination is always free. Companies participate in the Good as Gold Gala at a level that fits their team, whether through individual tickets, table sponsorships, or premier sponsorships.

## **Nominations Fee: \$0**

## **Individual Gala Tickets: \$325 – \$375**

# The Business Case for Recognition

Investing in the Admin Awards goes beyond recognition - it delivers measurable benefits for your organization, from higher retention to improved productivity. Here's how meaningful recognition translates into measurable ROI for your company.

Employees that don't feel valued are **2x as likely to quit** within a year (Gartner)

Employees that feel truly valued are **43% more productive** (Haas School of Business at UC Berkeley)

The cost to replace an Admin is conservatively estimated at **70% of their one-year salary**

## Retention Cost Savings Scenario:

If Admin Awards participation saves a company 3 Admins, making \$80k/year, savings = \$168,000

If we save one Admin? Savings = \$56,000


